- 4 To maintain protection, the venue management has undertaken to station hand sanitiser in the public areas and continue with screens around the bar.
- 5 In addition to the above measures, the chess club shall
 - provide hand sanitiser for compulsory use on entry to the playing area
 - maintain a register of everyone entering the playing area including contact details for visitors.
- 6 Members shall be required to inform the Covid designates listed above immediately they (or anyone in their household/support bubble) test positive for Covid-19 or strongly suspect infection due to their symptoms.
- 7 The Covid designates will broadcast the potential for infection to all possible contacts on the register for the appropriate session(s) and the Covid designate for any visiting team.

Directions to venue

From 1st September 2021, New England Chess Club will meet at

The Yard Of Ale 72 Oundle Road, Peterborough PE2 9PA 01733 348000

The best postcode for satnav to guide you to the parking area is probably PE2 9AG.

Directions by car are as follows :

1a) **From the City Centre :**

- Cross southward over the Town Bridge and fork right onto Oundle Road.
- Pass under the railway and after 200yds, take the first left into Grove St.

1b) **From the A1 :**

- Leave the A1 at Junction 17 following Fletton Parkway A1139 eastwards.
- Pass under the bridges for two junctions and take the sliproad at the third, turning left at the roundabout onto Nene Parkway A1260.
- After 350yds, leave the Parkway by the sliproad, turn right at the roundabout and after a short dual carriageway link, turn left onto Shrewsbury Avenue. Continue to the traffic lights at Oundle Road A605 where you turn right.
- Drive towards the City Centre along Oundle Rd. With a green open space appearing on your right (the road starts to dip ahead and a railway bridge just about comes into view), turn right into Grove St.

2) Once on Grove St, continue for 150yds and shortly beyond where the road swings left, turn right onto Orchard St for a further 50yds.

The parking area for about 20 cars lies between Ebenezer's and the community centre (https://www.instantstreetview.com/@52.565017,-0.248698,289.74h,-6.82p,1z,-k_E46nxO2XLY_s2NClqWA)

DO NOT PASS THROUGH THE LINE OF CONCRETE POSTS. This is a private car park for the local corner supermarket and fines are issued for improper use.

3) Leave the car and walk further through the car park to reach Oundle Rd where you turn left, pass the NISA supermarket and the Yard of Ale is next on the left.

- Backtrack towards the Town Bridge and fork left onto Oundle Road. The Yard of Ale is about 400yds away on the left-hand side of the road.
